They found their passion for community organizing during the resurgence of the BLM movement in May of 2020 and co-founded the Be Better Bryant initiative with three other alumni of color. Be Better Bryant launched an Instagram page to hold Bryant accountable for past inactions and to create a safe space for folks to learn and grow. The initiative helped raise over \$50,000 for the ICC Endowed Fund, created a petition of demands that was accepted by President Gittell, and hosted educational sessions for Bryant community members over the summer on topics like mass incarceration, intersectionality, and immigration. Nicole recently passed the CPA exam and currently works as an accounting associate at Haymarket Books and with several mutual aid groups in their community.

State Representative Quentin "Q" Phipps is honored to serve the 100th District in the Connecticut General Assembly. Representative Phipps is the first African-American to represent the City of Middletown in Connecticut's legislature. In Rep Q's first term, he served as the Vice-Chair of the Executive and Legislative Nominations Committee, Vice-Chair of the Progressive Caucus, and founded the Connecticut Downtown Main Street Caucus. Quentin is a graduate of Middletown Public Schools and Bryant University, and he earned his Master's of Public Administration from Villanova University. Quentin now serves Excellence Community Schools as their Director of Advocacy and Policy. Quentin is also the co-founder and co-director of EquityCT, a nonprofit dedicated to creating learning opportunities, building an actionable understanding of equity. Furthering his career in education, "Q" joined the University of Hartford's Interdisciplinary Studies (UIS) faculty as an adjunct professor. Quentin is a former community banker and Executive Director of the Middletown Downtown Business District. Quentin was named "40 Under 40" in Fairfield County Business Journal (2017) Hartford Business Journal (2015) and Connecticut Magazine (2013).
